This is a petition filed by the Chairperson, Consumer Grievances Redressal Forum, A.P.Central Power Distribution Company Ltd, Hyderabad for being provided with certain facilities and for solving certain problems being encountered by him in the discharge of his official functions. Upon considering the material available with it, the Commission passed the following:

ORDER

The petitioner has filed this petition against 17 respondents for providing certain facilities to him as Chairperson, Consumer Grievances Redressal Forum (for short 'CGRF'), Andhra Pradesh Central Power Distribution Company Limited (for short 'APCPDCL'), Hyderabad, and for solving certain problems being encountered by him

in the discharge of his official functions. However, as the CGRF comes under the jurisdiction of APCPDCL, notice was issued to the Chairman & Managing Director of APCPDCL (for short 'CMD), the Respondent No.5 herein. The CMD, APCPDCL, filed comments / objections on 15.05.2006 stating that the required facilities for functioning of CGRF were provided and that the Respondent No.5 has utmost reverence for the CGRF as it is a statutory body. The Respondent No.5 denied the allegations levelled by the petitioner as baseless, devoid of merits and requested the Commission to dismiss the petition.

The Chairperson, CGRF, APCPDCL, submitted letter No.CGRF/APCPDCL/Hyd/18/2006 dated 09.06.2006 stating that pending issues in regard to providing of facilities have been solved by the CMD, APCPDCL, on 29.05.2006 and that the CMD also assured to solve all other issues relating to pay, dearness allowance, traveling allowance etc., as per rules.

Having submitted the letter referred to above, the petitioner did not appear before the Commission on 01.07.2006, 29.07.2006 and 26.08.2006. As the petitioner has not evinced any interest to pursue the matter, even after being provided with repeated opportunities to make his representation before the Commission and has consequently failed to appear before the Commission on the above dates of hearing, the petition is dismissed.
