

PUBLIC NOTICE

The Andhra Pradesh Electricity Regulation Commission was constituted vide G.O.Ms.No.65, Energy (Power.III) Department, dated 31.03.1999 u/s 3 of the Andhra Pradesh Electricity Reform Act, 1998. Under section 1(2) of the Andhra Pradesh Electricity Reform Act, the jurisdiction of the Commission extends to the whole of the State of Andhra Pradesh.

2) The Andhra Pradesh Reorganisation Act, 2014 (Act 6 of 2014) has been gazetted on 01.03.2014. The State of Telangana will be carved out from the existing State of Andhra Pradesh on and from the Appointed Day. The appointed day has been notified as 2nd June, 2014. Thus, two States of Telangana and Andhra Pradesh will come into existence on 02.06.2014.

3) As per section 92 of the Andhra Pradesh Reorganisation Act, read with the Twelfth Schedule, the existing Andhra Pradesh Electricity Regulatory Commission (APERC) shall function as joint regulatory body for a period not exceeding 6 months within which time separate SERCs will commence functioning in the successor States.

4) It is now required for the Commission to make Regulation consequent to the reorganisation for regulation of the electricity sector in both the states of Telangana and Andhra Pradesh. Accordingly, in exercise of powers conferred u/s 181 of the Electricity Act, 2003 and other powers enabling in on this behalf, the Andhra Pradesh Electricity Regulatory Commission (APERC) hereby makes the following Regulation.

5) A "Draft" APERC (Reorganisation) Regulation, 2014 and is placed on the website of the Commission www.aperc.gov.in.

6) The Commission invites comments and suggestions of all the interested persons /stakeholders on this matter. The Comments/suggestions may be sent to the Commission Secretary/APERC on or before 5.00 PM on 22.05.2014 at the above mentioned address or through email commn_secy@aperc.gov.in.
