This Original Petition has come up for hearing before us today in the presence of Sri L. Venkateswara Rao, Sri Vineet Gupta, Advocates of M/s. Link Legal, Hyderabad, learned Counsel for the Petitioner; Sri G.V.Brahmananda Rao, Counsel representing Sri P.Shiva Rao, Learned Standing Counsel for the Respondents; that during the hearing the learned counsel for the petitioner sought permission of the Commission for withdrawal of the Original Petition; and that after carefully consideration, the Commission passed the following:

ORDER

This original petition is filed for the following reliefs :

- a. Determination of Base Rate of Variable Cost for the 2024-25 period qua the domestic coal in terms of Regulation 13 of the APERC Regulation No. 1 of 2008;
- b. Allow the Petitioner to recover the variable charges along with carrying cost in terms of the determined Base Rate of Variable Cost plus 15% ceiling in terms of earlier orders of the Hon'ble Commission to be applicable for FY 2024-25; and
- c. To pass any such appropriate order(s) as this Hon'ble Commission deems just.

At the hearing, Sri L. Venkateswara Rao, Advocate of M/s. Link Legal, Hyderabad, learned Counsel for the Petitioner, sought permission of this Commission to withdraw the Original Petition on the ground that it has become infructuous. Since the subject matter of the present Petition is already covered by the Order dated 30-12-2025 in O.P.No.12 of 2024 passed by this Commission, this Commission has directed the learned counsel for petitioner to file a memo seeking withdrawal of the petition. In compliance with the said direction, the counsel for petitioner has filed a memo seeking withdrawal of the Original Petition.

Sri G.V. Brahmananda Rao, counsel representing Sri P. Shiva Rao, learned Standing Counsel for the Respondents, has not raised any objection.

Recording the submission made by the learned counsel for the petitioner, the Original Petition is dismissed as withdrawn.
